
It is an honour for me to write these few words for this humble work about Tarīm — a place that changed my life and filled a space in my heart that words can hardly describe.

Tarīm taught me that life is meant to be simple, that true peace comes when Allāh is the One we live to please. There, I witnessed hearts that are kind, resilient, and unwavering in worship. I saw a people who have learned to decenter this world from their hearts, keeping it only in their hands.

In al-Arba‘īn al-Idrīsiyyah, it appears as: "Yā ‘Azīz al-Mānī‘ al-Ghālib ‘alā amrihi falā shay‘a yu‘ādiluhu."

Spiritual Benefits According to Al-Suhrawardī:

- Whoever recites it 1,000 times daily for seven consecutive days will see his opponent destroyed.
- Whoever recites it 70 times in the face of an enemy army and points towards them with his hand, they will be defeated.

This is the nearest path and the best means for the facilitation of provision and the easing of every difficulty, as stated explicitly in the Noble Qur'an. Allāh Most High says:

{And whoever fears Allāh, He will make for him a way out – and will provide for him from where he does not expect...} [al-Ṭalāq: 2–3]

And He, exalted is He, also says:

{And if they had remained steadfast upon the right path, We would have given them abundant water to drink.} [al-Jinn: 16]

The meaning of uprightiness is to refrain from what you have been forbidden and to do what you have been commanded. For sins are the gateway to disbelief and the remover of blessings. It has been said:

*If you are in a blessing, then guard it well,  
For sins remove the blessings bestowed.*

And you may see, dear brother, one who is wealthy and enjoying blessings while persisting in sins—but such blessings do not last long before they turn into punishment in life before death, especially in the case of major sins, such as disobedience to parents, fornication, and consuming people's wealth unjustly, and the like. We have witnessed this with our own eyes—for life itself is a school.


